Position Summary

Youth Sports Officials impact the lives of youth and families through implementing the rules, direct care, organization, supervision and well-being of participants in the sports activity.

Core and Strategic Functions

- Shows emotional maturity
- Ability to work with participants of various ages with a focus on youth
- Ability to relate effectively to diverse groups of people from all social and economic segments of the community and successful clearance of background check
- Indoor/outdoor environment, regular walking and running required
- Sufficient strength, agility and mobility to perform essential functions required
- Reliable transportation and on-site, regular weekend schedule required
- Understands and implements rules of assigned sport, focusing on participant experience and safety at all times
- Provides interpretation and demonstration to all participants, including those with special needs
- Actively participates in department meetings and trainings
